

County Highway CV – Between Wisconsin Highway 19 and Vinburn Road, Public Involvement Meeting

You are invited to attend a **Public Involvement Meeting** (PIM) regarding this roadway project.

The purpose of the PIM is to provide a brief reminder of the proposed construction and offer further information on traffic impacts during construction. The meeting will be an open-house format with a brief presentation at 5:30 P.M. Project exhibits will be on display for your review and project personnel will be available to discuss the improvements on an individual basis after the presentation. Your attendance and comments are appreciated. The proposed Phase II County Highway CV rehabilitation project is scheduled to begin in the Spring of 2026. This is the second phase of a 2.98-mile rehabilitation project extending from WIS 19 to Vinburn Road. The purpose of this project is to improve the existing pavement condition and upgrade the drainage facilities. Phase I included replacing select culverts, sanitary and water line upgrades, and underground utility work. Phase II includes intersection improvements, pulverizing the existing pavement and relaying 5-inches of asphalt, replacing existing mixed curb and gutter with new concrete curb and gutter, replacing deteriorated retaining walls, upgrading guardrail to current standards, and installing new pavement markings.

County Highway CV will be closed to through traffic during this project, but homeowners, customers, and emergency services will still have access to all homes and businesses. Message boards will be used to give advance notice of closures/detours. Any full closures of the roadway will be communicated to residents along County Highway CV as well as documented on our website prior to closure. For the safety of our crews, residents are encouraged to slow down and be alert when using an active construction zone to access their driveways. Identify alternate routes so the closures will be less disruptive. Avoid the active construction zone during the work day if possible.
